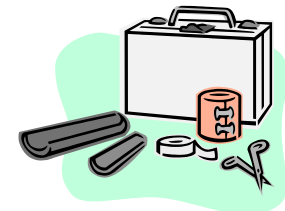

- ♦ Heartsaver CPR is valid for a period of 2 years from date of completion. First Aid is valid for a period of 3 years from date of completion.
- ♦ Instructors will supply all training equipment, workbooks and electronic equipment.
- ♦ All our instructors are licensed/certified health care professionals with a minimum of 15 years "Real Life" experience.
- ♦ Instructors are familiar with local communities and will educate students on how to request local emergency services (911), what to expect when they arrive, including Information on local hospitals and their specialties.
